We are seeking quotations for the following scope of work:

Scope of Work

1. Electrical Upgrade:

- Installation of a new circuit board (consumer unit) to support increased appliance usage.
- Rewiring and installation of additional outlets as required to accommodate modern kitchen equipment.
- o Compliance with all relevant safety standards and regulations.

2. Testing and Certification:

- Conduct full electrical and appliance testing to ensure safety and compliance.
- Provide certification upon completion of work.

3. **Project Timeline**:

 Provide a detailed project timeline from commencement to completion.

- All work must comply with UK building and safety regulations.
- Contractors must provide proof of relevant qualifications and insurance.
- A breakdown of costs, including materials, labour, and any additional expenses, should be included in the quotation.
- Details of warranty and aftercare services.
